Some other indications that children would benefit from Young Fives are: Has difficulty doing small muscle activities (cutting, coloring, drawing, writing); Needs frequent changes of activity; Has a hard time sitting still; Has difficulty following directions; Has trouble sharing; Does not like to wait for his turn; Immature social skills; Has trouble interacting appropriately with adults; Has a short attention span
